## Charles Farrar

### Turning Hollow Forms, texturing, and coloring.

Charles started by telling a little background on his turning. He showed some of his work and told where they are. He also told a little history of the lathe. He talked about design of his works and why he turns mostly hollow vessels. He next showed how he shapes the vessel and how he hollows them. He used hollowing tools that looked like the D-Way hollowing tools. He hollowed the piece to about  $\frac{3}{8}$ " thick. This would allow the piece to be pierced and remain solid. After the hollowing, he then showed us how he gets the texturing on the vessel. He used a Dremel tool with various sized burrs. He made the burred opening larger near the largest part of the vessel and got smaller as he approached the top. He showed us how he put a collar on the opening at the top and how the texturing came up to the collar. After the texturing, he showed us how he colors the piece. He started with a dark color first. He used Marine #35 black dye first. Then he used a dark green acrylic paint and followed with a lighter green to highlight the dark green. He next used a copper acrylic paint to give a tarnished copper look.

Mike Regner had the bring back box and he made a very nice votive candle.




I did not get the name of who won the bring back this month. If it was you or you know who did, please let me know.
